Taking into consideration the provisions of art. 7 Rights and duties of the parties, paragraph 16, section Managing Authority of the subsidy contract, art. 7 Rights and duties of the parties, paragraph 11, section Managing Authority of the co-financing contract and art. 6 Rights and duties of the parties, paragraph 11, section Managing Authority of the monitoring agreement, the Managing Authority issues the following:

INSTRUCTION FOR BENEFICIARIES

In order to ensure a proper mechanism of spending forecast at Programme level and ensuring the necessary amounts for payments, the Lead Beneficiary will attach in the eMS system a spending forecast at project level - scanned document (in section Application Form/ Attachments, file name "Spending forecast (initial)", according to the template below - Table 1), in maximum 10 working days after signing the subsidy contract.
