Designation of managing authorities and state of execution of interim payments of 2014-2020 ESIF Operational Programmes

(Status as of 31st May 2016)

Dear President,

Please find enclosed the monthly progress report providing information on the following subjects:

#### Programmes 2007-2013,

- the state of execution of interim payments and the submission of payment applications as of 31<sup>st</sup> May 2016, where total execution of interim payments reached €285.4 billion, an increase of €2.3 billion compared to the previous month. Submission of new payment applications in 2016 reached €5.0 billion;
- the evolution of the "backlog" of outstanding payment claims taking into consideration these new applications and the payments made at the end of May 2016 stood at €5.4 billion.

#### Programmes 2014-2020,

In addition to the 562 European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF) programmes including FEAD adopted by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2015, a new Operational Programme 'SME Initiative, Romania' was adopted in 2016 which gives a total number of 563 adopted ESIF operational programmes. The report focuses on the designation of managing and certifyting authorities and on the payments related to interim payment applications:

- as of 31<sup>st</sup> May 2016 the total execution of interim payments reached €8.219 billion, an increase of €1.339 billion compared to the execution recorded up to 30<sup>th</sup> April 2016;
- by 31<sup>st</sup> May 2016, the Commission had received notifications of designation of authorities for 239 programmes, which represents an increase by 24 compared to the situation at the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2016. The total number of designated authorities covers also

However, some programmes have been adopted without taking into account this transfer and will have to be revised. In such cases, the corresponding amount is not included in the table above until the programmes are revised.
