### GENERAL ORIENTATION<sup>1</sup>

In this case, only administrative<sup>3</sup> check shall be carried out by the external experts assessing the state aid incidence.
- D. Projects including activities that are declared Services for General Economic Interest (SGEI) (e.g.: Investments in health-care and prevention-related infrastructure, Purchase and installation of health-care equipment, delivery of training to staff on the use of new equipment;), in the operating phase. Considering that the SGEI occurs during the operating phase of the project, the investments envisaged may be started before the entrustment of the SGEI, provided that the Applicant undertakes to have the entrustment act adopted until the operating phase.
